

Dear Friends of Cat NAPS:

As you know, I keep topics of a 'general' nature in this newsletter but this time I wanted to share my personal story.

I grew up in a home where we always had a dog and various other small pets, but never a cat. About 20 years ago I was living in my first apartment and rescued my first two kittens. One other notable high that happened in 2012 was that another dear friend of mine got me involved with Cat NAPS. My journey to help felines of all shapes, sizes, ages, and colors began!

Within these past 4 years, my cat knowledge has grown and I continue to learn – cats have so much to teach us! Never has my heart been so full, and sometimes so broken, as when I look into the eyes of a rescue. If only they could talk. If only they could tell their story. If only...

Since becoming involved with Cat NAPS, I have fallen in love with many more cats; two in particular more so than the others. Needless to say, I adopted Oscar in 2014 and Meringue last year. I often ask Meringue and the other Cat NAPS rescues about how their journey began before coming to the shelter.
